**The Martinez**

Don Eduardo Reposado, Cointreau, sugar and fresh lime juice.

**Swig**

Skyy infused with seasonal fruit.  
Shaken over ice and served straight up. Ask your server for today’s selection.

**Cosmopolitan**

Skyy Citrus, Cointreau, cranberry juice and fresh lime juice.

**Frozen Cosmopolitan**

Frozen version of this classic Martini.

**Dirty Martini**

Citadelle Gin, Noilly Prat Vermouth and a splash of olive juice, garnished with Spanish olives.  
*“I must get out of these wet clothes and into a dry Martini.”* —Mae West

**Gibson**

Vodka or gin, Noilly Prat Vermouth and Spanish cocktail onions.  
*“A well-made dry Martini or Gibson, correctly chilled and nicely served, has been more often my true friend than any two-legged creature.”* —M. F. K. Fisher

**The St. Valentine**

Absolut Peppar, Swig’s own Bloody Mary mix garnished with anchovy olives and a lime.

**Chocolate Martini**

Skyy, Wild Spirit, and White Crème de Cacao liqueur in a chocolate-rimmed glass.  
*“Candy is dandy, but liquor is quicker.”* —Ogden Nash

**Blue Moon Martini**

Skyy Citrus and a splash of Blue Curacao.  
*“There is something about a martini,  
A tingle remarkably pleasant;  
A yellow, a mellow Martini,  
I wish I had one at present.  
There is something about a Martini.  
Ere the dining and dancing begin,  
And to tell you the truth,  
It is not the vermouth—  
I think that perhaps it’s the gin.”*

**Mangopolitan**

Finlandia Mango, Cointreau, cranberry juice, and a splash of fresh lime.

**Strawberry Kiss**

Smirnoff Strawberry, White Creme de Cacao, and Godiva White in a chocoalte rimmed glass.

**Hemingway Martini**

Beefeater Gin, Noilly Prat Vermouth and Spanish cocktail onions.  
*“... As five o’clock approaches, my thoughts turn toward the elixir of quietude. Gin stops the bell from tolling.”* —Ernest Hemingway

**The Vesper**

1/2 Smirnoff Vodka, 1/2 Tanqueray Gin and Noilly Prat Vermouth.  
Named after Vesper Lynd from the 007 movie, Casino Royale. Lynd, the gin and vodka Martini again.

**Sapphire Martini**

Bombay Sapphire Gin in a chilled glass rinsed with Cointreau and garnished with an anchovy stuffed olive.  
E. B. White proudly admitted that he drank Martinis “the way other people take aspirin,” imbibing them at lunch and dinner until he was well into his eighties.

**Sir Winston Churchill Martini**

Tanqueray Gin in a sherry-lined glass.  
Sir Winston Churchill, by his own account, made Martinis by pouring gin in a pitcher and glancing briefly at a bottle of vermouth across the room.  
*Enjoy a classic Churchill cigar for \$7.50 extra.*

**Goldfinger**

Gordon’s Gin and Noilly Prat Vermouth garnished with Spanish olives.  
*“Shaken not stirred.”* —James Bond

**The Red Slipper**

El Jimador Tequila and Cointreau in a cabernet sauvignon-lined glass.  
*“I like to have a martini, two at the very most—  
After three I’m under the table, After four I’m under my host.”*

**Lemon Drop**

Skyy Citrus, fresh lime juice, and sugar with a sugar rim.

**Flirtini**

Grey Goose Vodka, Chambord, pineapple juice and topped with champagne. Famous from the popular HBO program, Sex and the City.

**The Soprano Martini**

Skyy Vodka, Amaretto, Tuaca, and pineapple juice.  
*“Like the Italian but Americanized.”* —Dante Bocancinni

**Sour Apple Martini**

Skyy Vodka and Apple Pucker.

**Victoria’s Secret**

Smirnoff Strawberry, cranberry, topped with champagne.
